BRANCH PRESIDENT (BP)

Honorarium \$700

- Attends one mandatory Council meeting a month with the T/OT Bargaining Unit (BU) and holds monthly OSSTF meetings, typically at the end of staff meetings.
- Participates as a member of the In–School Staffing Committee (ISC).
- Assists members with contract and member related issues, with the support of the BU office staff.
- Facilitates Branch Executive meetings.

BRANCH VP

- Participates as a member of the In–School Staffing Committee.
- Leads various initiatives with the guidance of the BU.
- Assists the Branch President as required.
 - This may include supporting with meetings, info sharing, structure tests, votes, or organizing meetings, calling Branch Executive meetings, monitoring APAs, or planning a member engagement activity.

HUMAN RIGHTS COMMITTEE REP

- Attend HR committee meetings, 3–4 per year.
- Promote Human Rights activities in your school.

COMMUNICATION & POLITICAL ACTION REP

- Attend CPAC committee meetings, 4–6 per year.
- Help facilitate organizing conversations and collective actions.
- Promote political action
 activities with your school.

SCHOOL COUNCIL REP

- Attend monthly School Council meetings.
- Seek staff input regarding matters being discussed at School Council meetings.
- Deliver information at School Council meetings on behalf of OSSTF.
- Encourage the School Council to be active supporters in the public of public education.

ED SERVICES COMMITTEE REP

- Attend Educational Services Committee meetings, 3–4 times per year.
- Promote Ed Services activities within the school, including conference funding and the Unsung Hero Award.

ISC REP

In addition to the BP and BVP, there is 1 position on the In–School Staffing Committee. The ISC:

- Ensures the collective agreement is followed during the staffing process.
- Advocates on behalf of members during the meetings.

STATUS OF WOMEN COMMITTEE REP

- Attend SWC committee meetings, 3–4 per year.
- Facilitate the Winter Warmth fundraiser at your school.
- Promote SWC activities, member events, and workshops within the school.
