Job Summary

Every two years, the D16 T/OT Bargaining Unit holds an election for select positions on the Executive. To facilitate the election, an Election Committee is created from a group of OSSTF D16 T/OT members. The Election Committee is made up of the DEO, a Time-Release Officer, up to 1-2 Election Officer(s) and up to 5 Branch President Volunteers.

Responsibilities of the Election Officer(s) include:

- Reviewing the Elections Manual
- Attending Election Committee Meetings as needed
- Assisting the DEO in reviewing election media-sheets to flag any negative campaigning
- Tabulating ballots after hours on Voting Day
- Participating in the Results Meeting (if needed)
